

#### **IMPACT REPORT**



Michigan Gov. Gretchen Whitmer was joined by Lt. Gov. Garlin Gilchrist II at a March 18, 2021, news conference to announce the launch of Ford Field as Michigan's largest on-site COVID-19 vaccination clinic.

Other keynote speakers were Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region 5 Acting Regional Administrator **Kevin M. Sligh Sr.**, Detroit Lions Team President and CEO **Rod Wood**, Henry Ford Health System President and CEO **Wright Lassiter III**, Meijer President and CEO **Rick Keyes** and Protect Michigan Commission Director **Kerry Ebersole Singh.** 

Stakeholders and reporters from across Michigan attended the in-person event at the Detroit site. Partners included representatives from Henry Ford Health System, Meijer, FEMA and local government. Top media attendees included The Detroit News, WXYZ-TV, Crain's Detroit Business, WDIV-TV, WWMT-TV and MLive.

Within 24 hours of the news conference, more than 40,000 Michiganders registered to receive their vaccines at Ford Field.


On March 22, **Lt. Gov. Gilchrist, Singh** and members of Michigan's congressional delegation toured the Ford Field mass vaccination clinic with leading representatives from FEMA and the U.S. Department of Defense.

**EARNED MEDIA:** From March 18-26, news coverage of the launch of the Ford Field vaccination site and subsequent events **reached an estimated 901 million people** (calculated by the number of unique IP addresses that visit a news article within a given time). If the media coverage was purchased as paid advertising, it would have cost **\$14 million**. *Links to key stories are on pages 2-6.*



Detroit - Gov. Gretchen Whitmer and other officials gathered at Ford Field Thursday to highlight Michigan's largest single-site vaccination effort, which is expected to administer more than 300,000 doses of COVID-19 vaccine beginning

The COVID-19 mass vaccination clinic is set to open Wednesday. During the next eight weeks, the site is expected to distribute 335,000 doses in addition to the state's allocation from the federal government that is going to hospitals and health departments and pharmacies, Whitmer said.





Starting Tuesday, Michigan's largest COVID-19 vaccination clinic begins delivering shots into arms.

In the past week, 110,000 people have signed up to get their coronavirus vaccine at Ford Field in Detroit.

More than 14,000 appointments are scheduled for this week, with another 20,000 appointment invitations going out Monday.

But there are some doctors who hope the state will soon start channeling vaccines through their offices.

### Video: Mass Vaccination Site Opens At Detroit's Ford Field — See What To Expect

A video, photos and updated details are added to earlier coverage.

A public health mission with military support kicked off ahead of schedule in Detroit at Michigan's first federal Covid mass vaccination site. Ford Field opened for a "soft launch" a day before Wednesday's originally scheduled debut.

"I'm not usually smiling walking out of Ford Field, but I am today," tweets Birmingham accountant Eric Wydra, 49. "First vaccine done! Really impressed with the organized process they put in place."

More than 2,600 people reportedly were vaccinated in private, screened cubicles -- including walk-ins without appointments. A time-lapse **video below** shows the process, compressed into two minutes.

▶ Update: "Walk-up appointments are not available Wednesday, but we will share how to find out when these appointments are available later in the week," the state health department posts on its Facebook feed. Check there for fresh information.




