The spotted lanternfly is an invasive insect that has been found in Michigan. It can harm fruit crops and trees and be a nuisance. If you see one, take a picture, squish it and report it.

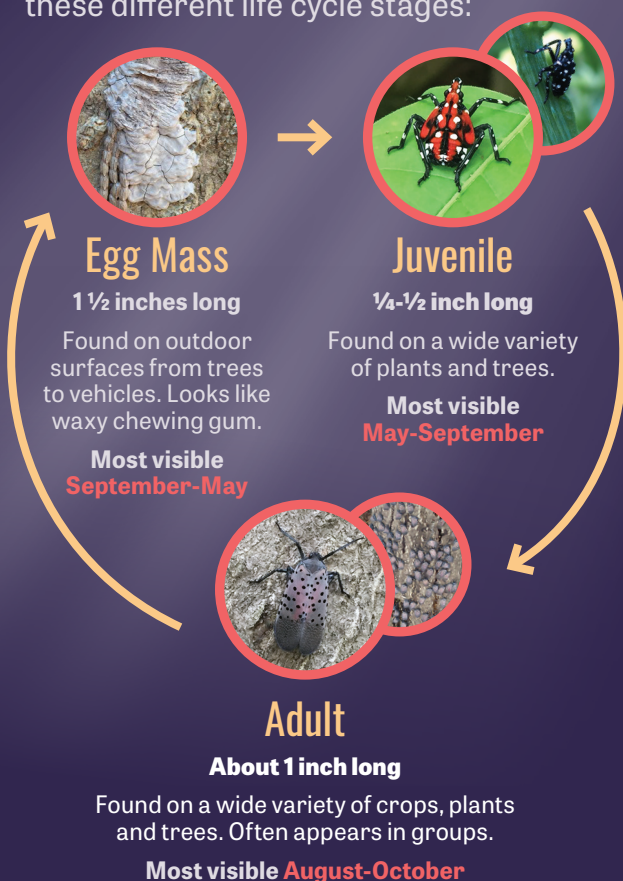
